- What/why do you want to study? Why Ph.D.? Why Master? Why Second Master? (Visa Interview)
- What do you like in CA, US,...? (Visa Interview)
- Why did you choose to study in this country? What do you like about it? Why not Iran? (Visa Interview)
- Experience and related background (Academic & Jobs) (Visa Interview)
- What additional skills are you planning to gain? (Visa Interview)
- Post graduation plan? (Visa Interview)
- Your expectations from the university and the program? (Visa Interview)
- Supervisor, and why him/her? (Visa Interview)
- Your personality, unique characteristic (Charity) (Visa Interview)

TIPS TO SUCCESS!

- Original (Copy = Reject)
- Specific (University, Major)
- Newspaper or novel?
 - Newspaper: I love to work for a software company
 - Novel: Late in the night. I'd found myself in the middle of a deserted office and 15000 lines of codes!
 - Be creative (Review SOP books and real SOPs)
 - Use numbers: I taught math for a group of 10 persons, for a period of 3 months.
- Formal but friendly
- Portray yourself
 - Passion, eagerness
 - Intelligence
 - Well-prepared

TIPS TO SUCCESS!

- Be yourself!
- Write stories, if you have!
- Dim your weakness
- Instead of defending, point out the actual reasons.
- Problems and challenges: How you overcame? What you've learnt?
 - I hope you ignore my low speaking sub-score which was due to confusion between English and French;
 therefore, it made me some inconveniences in pronunciation while taking the TOEFL exam.

PROOFREAD (DOUBLE CHECK!)

- Grammar
- Idioms, slang words, phrasal verbs
- Check your SOP with Grammarly, Gmail, Office, ...
- Try not to change and update your SOP for Visa interview
- Check with native people if it is possible for you

GTE (Genuine Temporary Entrant)

- GTE letter for Embassy
- GTE form asked by university
- All applicants for a Student visa must show they are coming to Australia temporarily to gain a quality education.
- You should provide evidence, proof, and information regarding your previous study, gap in previous studies, current and previous employment, ties to country of residence, and economic situation country of residence.
- more vitally important for self-funded students
- EOI (Expression of Interest) (Australia)
